	All other Palliative/ EOL patients (those <u>not</u> at high risk of dying in next 2 weeks) assessed in consultation with MRP.	1 Designated Visitor <u>or</u> 1 Designated Alternate daily during fixed visiting hours	11am-9pm Up to 2-hour visit
Critical Illness	Unstable patient, precipitous decline in condition	1 Designated Visitor <u>or</u> 1 Designated Alternate daily	24 hours a day Up to 2-hour visit

Emergency Department	Time dependent on need for essential care partners to support clinical team with timely assessment, obtaining consent to plans of care and discharge planning.	1 Designated visitor	24 Hours a day
Under 18	Includes care by parent	1 Designated visitor	24 Hours a day No in and out privileges
Childbirth	Includes Post Partum		
Mental health		1 Designated visitor	11 a.m. to 9 p.m. Up to 2-hour visit
Cognitive Impairment	Unstable patient, precipitous decline		
Major Surgery	Anticipated length of stay more than 3 days		
Unable to Effectively Communicate	E.g. significant language barrier and all means of remote communication failed

Patient Requiring Caregiver to Support Hospital Workflow	Unmet care need or absence of caregiver causes undue burden on healthcare team (inpatient and outpatient)	1 Designated visitor	Times adjusted to meet care needs at the discretion of the unit
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
