There was an imminent need for our Ontario Health Team, the North York Toronto Health Partners (NYTHP), to expand its capacity to lead the COVID-19 vaccination rollout including the 5–11-year-olds, third doses and continued vaccination of North York communities with the lowest vaccination rates in Toronto. NYGH is the fundholder for the vaccination roll out on behalf of the 21 partners in our Ontario Health Team. The immediacy of this need did not allow time to engage in an RFP process to acquire the specialized skills and experiences to manage a program of this scale, complexity and risk. KPMG had resources with direct experience leading the operations of a regional vaccination program involving public health, hospitals, primary care, government and community organizations in other regions within Ontario. The resource from KPMG recently led a vaccination program for an entire region in Ontario and has the specific and proven experience, skills and leadership abilities to support North York's vaccination program at this time.
